WHEREAS, this court has previously ordered the Presentence Investigations of all potential mental health court participants be made available to a Mental Health Court Clinician, to assist and expedite the legitimate purpose of the Department of Correction in supervising mental health court participants; and in accordance with I.C.R. 32(h)(1) and (2),

NOW THEREFORE IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

That the previous order dated August 9, 2005, is hereby amended to allow all Mental Health Court Clinicians and the Fifth Judicial District Mental Health Court Coordinator access to any P.S.I. on any defendant being considered for admission into the Fifth Judicial District Mental Health Court for the purpose of determining suitability into the program pursuant to I.C.R 32(h)(2). All uses of any P.S.I. Report shall be in accordance with the provisions of I.C.R. 32(h)(1) regarding disclosure.
