The City currently has outstanding indebtedness of \$817,038, payable solely from water system revenues and outstanding indebtedness of \$4,182,059, payable solely from sewer system revenues. The interest rate anticipated on the proposed bonds is 2.25%. The range of anticipated rates is from 1.0% to 3.5%. The total proposed principal amount to be repaid over the life of the bonds is \$6,100,000; the total interest to be paid over the life of the bonds, based on the anticipated interest rate is \$3,183,336; the total amount to be repaid over the life of the bonds is \$9,283,336.
