On March 31, 2014, the U.S. Department of Homeland Security's Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) approved the *Twin Falls County All Hazard Mitigation Plan* as a multi-jurisdictional local plan as outlined in 44 CFR Part 201. With approval of this plan, the following entities are now eligible to apply for the Robert T. Stafford Disaster Relief and Emergency Assistance Act's hazard mitigation project grants through March 31, 2019:






