The reservation fee varies on the pavilions due to the capacity of the pavilion: also there is a \$50.00 cleaning/damage deposit. The park staff will check the said pavilion for cleanliness/damages after your event. If the pavilion is deemed clean and without damages your deposit will be reimbursed to you through a county claim and check within 2 weeks. Your check will be mailed to you via U.S. Postal Service. This reservation fee is just for a specific pavilion. Due to Joe Public the Parks Department cannot guarantee a clean pavilion. If upon arrival you find that the pavilion is not clean please call our on call number at (208)539-3128. Due to certain individuals occupying a reserved pavilion, please take the reservation form with you to the event. If someone refuses to leave after showing your reservation, call the sheriff's dispatch @ 735-1911. They CAN be cited for TRESPASSING.

PARK REGULATIONS:

- No uncased firearms, hunting or shooting within the park
- No glass beverage containers will be allowed within the park
- Even though permission has been given to use a specific shelter or pavilion on a desired day, the park will still be opened to public. However, other individuals will be advised of your use.
- Dogs are only allowed in park if they are on a leash. Owner and/or handler are required to carry a "pooper scooper" and clean up after pets at ALL times.
- **"PACK OUT WHAT YOU PACK IN"**. We ask that all users pick up and remove ALL debris generated from their function and leave the area clean.
- Please **DO NOT** move the trash cans, tables, or benches as you **WILL NOT** receive your deposit back if moved.
- **Cancellations** of pavilions need to be made at least 48 hours in advance to insure refund of any fees and deposits.

Any damages or destruction of a pavilion, tables, benches, sprinkler systems, will be the responsibility of the signee and will be held liable and will be billed for the damages. By signing this form you have read and agree to all park regulations.
