RESOLUTION NO. 2010 -- 029

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS FOR TWIN FALLS COUNTY, IDAHOAPPROVING THE CREATION OF A COUNTY ELECTION FUND

WHEREAS, in 2009 the Idaho Legislature adopted HB372aaS, which amended the election laws to provide that all elections in Idaho would be consolidated and that counties would conduct all elections; and

WHERAS, Idaho Code §31-809A provides that a county election fund shall be established by resolution and that election funds received from the state or political subdivisions for conducting elections shall be deposited into this fund, along with funds budgeted by the county may be deposited into this fund to pay for all costs in conducting political subdivision elections.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that a county election fund, named "Election Consolidation Fund #137", is hereby established in Twin Falls County.

- 1. Funds received from the state or other political subdivisions for the conduct of elections in Twin Falls County shall be deposited into the Election Consolidation Fund.
- 2. Funds budgeted by Twin Falls County to conduct the primary and general elections may be deposited or transferred into the Election Consolidation Fund.
- 3. Funds deposited in the Election Consolidation Fund may be accumulated from year to year or expended on a regular basis and shall be used to pay for all costs in conducting political subdivision elections in Twin Falls County.
